

Festivals of the World Summer 2 Eagles

PSHE

During our weekly SCARF lessons we will be exploring rights and respect; considering people, the environment and money. Our SCIB week will focus on Protective behaviours and Positive relationships.

PE

In Games we will focus on defence and attack skills. Athletics will explore locomotion through running.

Art

We will be focusing on printing. We will explore printing using body parts, relief print with plasticine and additive and incised printing on foam boards. We will use our gained knowledge to create our own festival inspired pattern design and print it.

English

Our Key texts are Lila and the Secret of Rain and To Carnival- a celebration in St Lucia. We will make predictions, investigate settings, analyse characters and events. We will be writing postcards, a tourist brochure and our own version of a celebratory story and conclude with a letter recounting a visit to Paris' Fete de la Musique. On Wednesdays we will explore poetry from the Caribbean and write our own verse.

Geography

We will use maps, globes and photographs to explore Wroxtton, the UK and different locations around the world. We will be learning about the physical and human features of each locality and what everyday life is like living there. We will be contrasting locations. In French week we will be identifying which countries have French as an official language. Our project will conclude by tasting food from different countries.

Music

We will be exploring composing, listening and performing. We will devise our own storm music, sing Kenyan chants and investigate different traditional Kenyan music and dance. We will listen and respond to Caribbean calypso, reggae and steel drum pieces before creating our own calypso. The project will conclude with us learning a French greeting song and performing in the Fete de la Musique

Maths

In Number we will be investigating place value within 100. We will explore counting, ordering, partitioning, comparing, addition and subtraction. In Measures we will be investigating time. We will learn months, days, hours, minutes and seconds before telling time to the hour and half hour. On Wednesday's our focus will be money.
